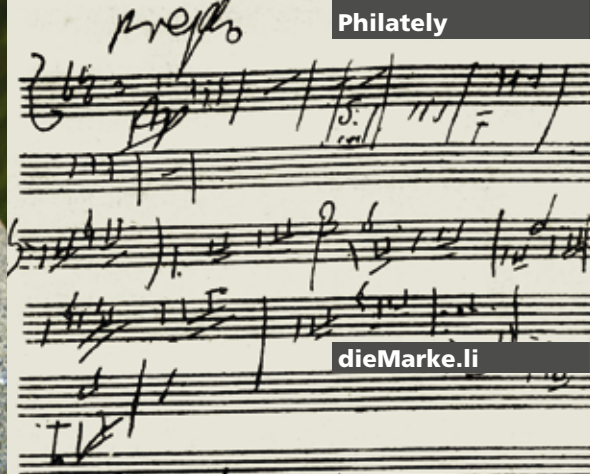

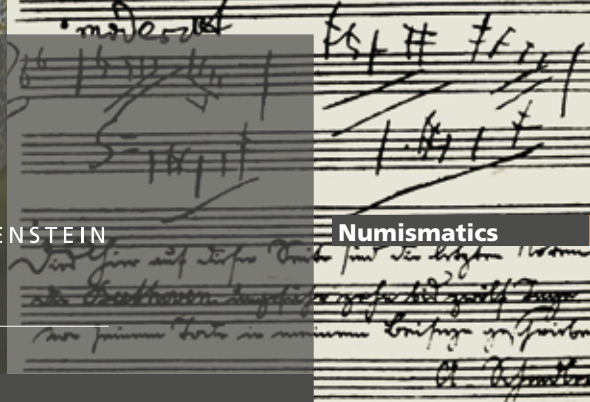

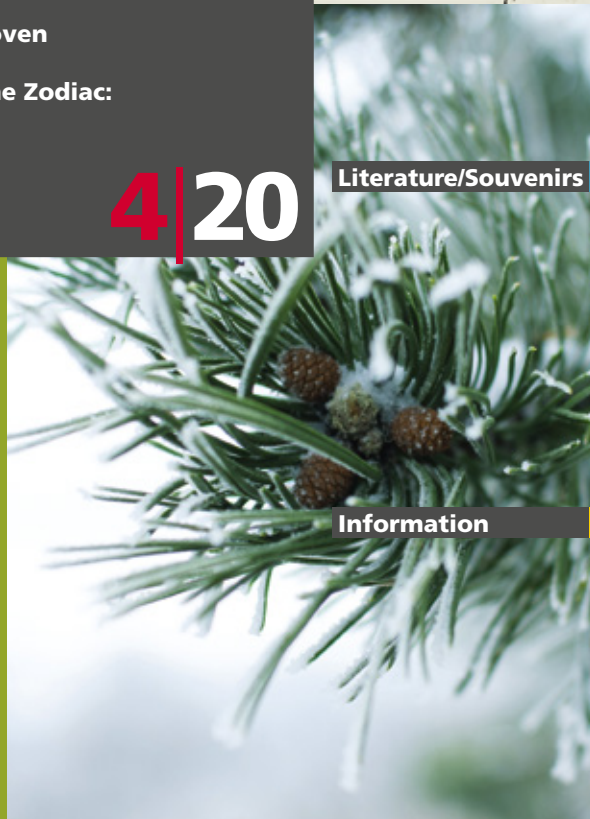

# 250<sup>th</sup> Birthday of Ludwig van Beethoven

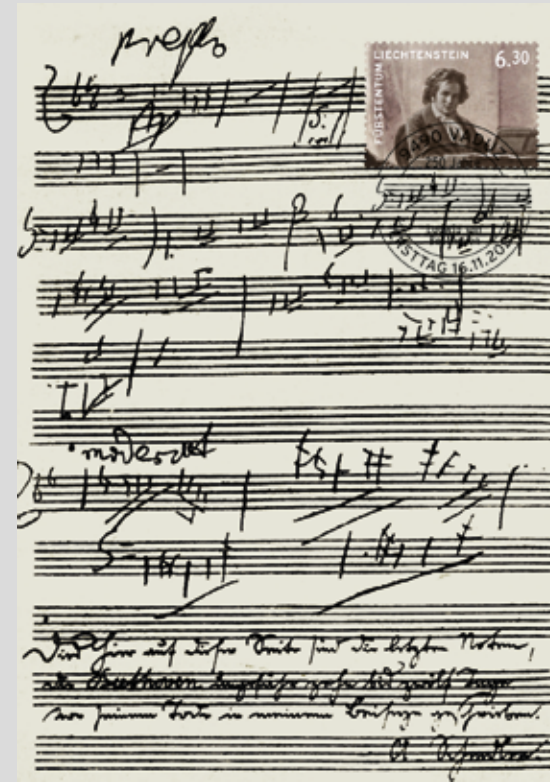
Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

With the souvenir sheet "With Friends at the Piano" (face value: CHF 6.30), Philately Liechtenstein is commemorating the 250<sup>th</sup> birthday of the renowned composer Ludwig van Beethoven. The souvenir sheet, which was produced in steel engraving, shows the artist sitting at the piano surrounded by friends. Beethoven was born in Bonn in 1770, although only the date of his baptism on 17 December is known. As a child he learned to play the piano, organ and violin and gave his first concert at the tender age of seven. In 1792, Beethoven moved to Vienna where he remained until the end of his life in 1827. When he died, the age of the Viennese Classicism also came

to an end. Beethoven is considered a pioneer of the romantic period and, in addition to his nine symphonies, he wrote a large number of piano and chamber music works, Lieder, as well as the opera Fidelio and other dramatic works. Besides music, he was also interested in philosophy, literature and politics. By the age of 27, Beethoven had already become hard of hearing. This condition worsened until he was almost deaf and often left the composer desperate. Experts assume that was the reason why the genius with the tousled mop of hair is to be seen with a grouchy expression in so many portraits.

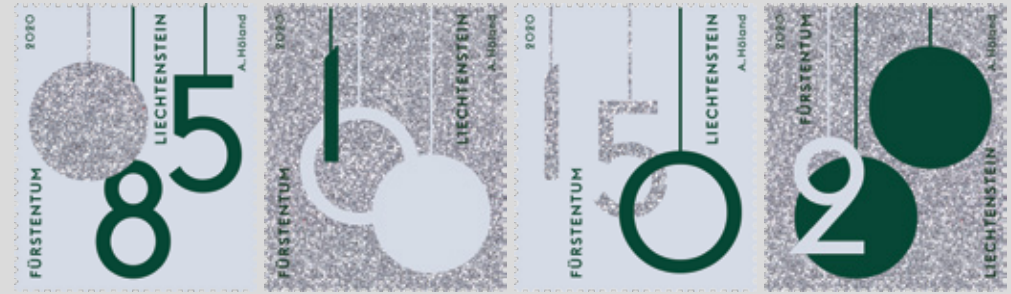
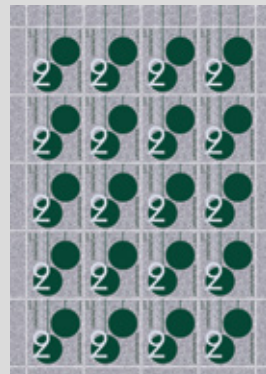
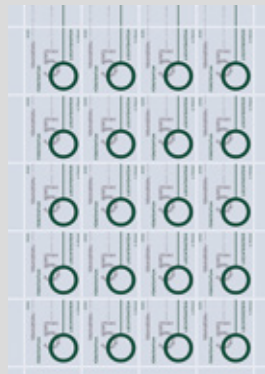
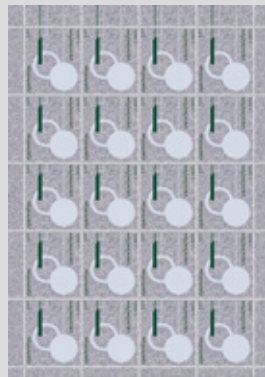
The self-adhesive special stamps of this year's Christmas issue are presented in a glittering and shimmering fashion. They were designed by the third prize winner of a design competition held abroad among Liechtenstein artists.

Designer Annett Höland decided to reduce the graphic design of the four stamps "Glistening Snow" (face value: CHF 0.85), "Sparkling Night" (face value: CHF 1.00), "Candle Glow" (face value: CHF 1.50) and "Tinsel Rain" (face value: CHF 2.00) to key elements. The colourfulness and vividness of the Christmas stamps is achieved by holographic foil printing. The light blue background is reminiscent of the blue shimmer of fresh snow. Fir green and the colourfulness of the hologram foil, which ranges from elegant silver to bright gold and warm red depending on the angle of view, round off the Christmas colour

spectrum. All the numerals of the face values hang decoratively from the upper edge of the stamp into the picture with the zeros depicted as Christmas baubles. Arranged as a group on the first day cover, the stamps together form a harmonious and self-contained composition.

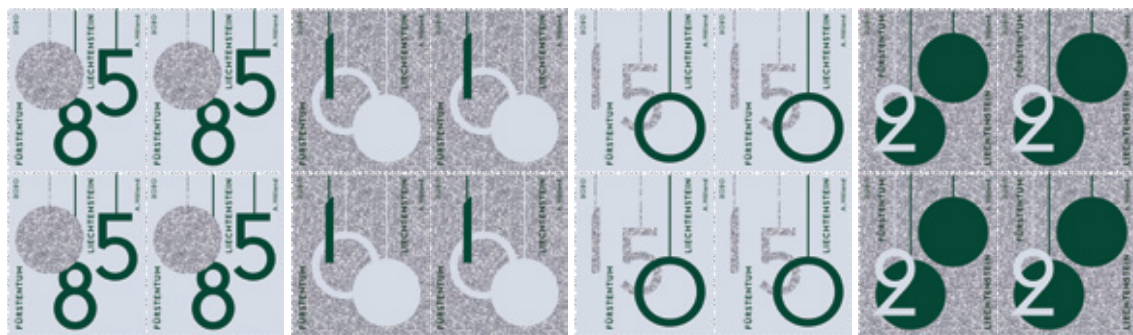

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

For the tenth time in a row, Philately Liechtenstein is issuing a stamp at the end of the year with a motif from the Chinese zodiac, of which the sign in the coming year will be the ox. The Chinese New Year is celebrated on the first new moon between 21 January and 21 February and is the most important Chinese holiday. Traditionally it is celebrated with many ancient customs. For example, people open their windows and doors on this day to let happiness in. The self-adhesive special stamp "Year of the Ox" (face value: CHF 2.00) was once again this year designed in the form of a filigree silhouette and produced using state-of-the-art laser technology. The sheet combines four stamps and is punched out in the shape of an ox. Gold foil stamping gives it a classy touch.

In the Chinese horoscope, the ox (also known as a buffalo) is attributed with qualities such as diligence, reliability, strength and determination. According to the description, it is sincere and likes to take on responsibility. In contrast to this, however, it can also be stubborn, selfish, reserved and distrustful.
