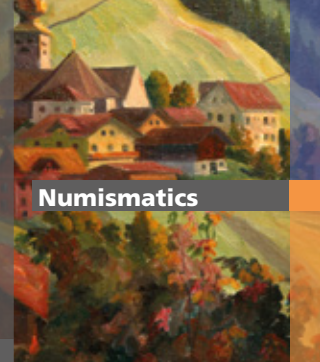

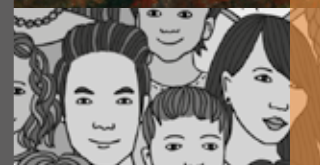

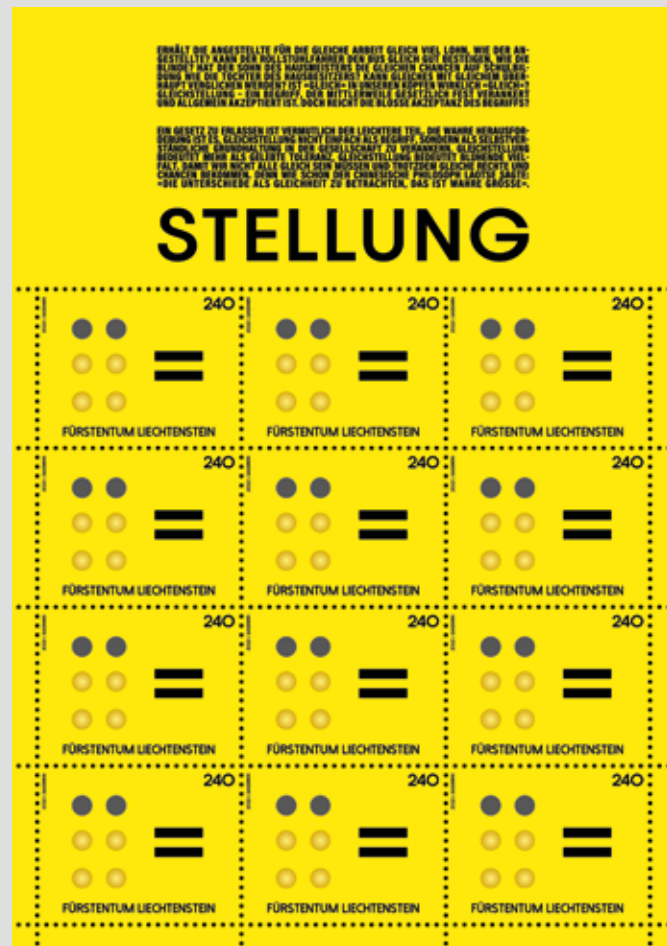
Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

The terms "equality" and "equal rights" are widely recognised. Indeed, for many years they have been enshrined in law in many countries of the Western world. But is that enough? How can a society practise true equality? As early as the 6th century B.C., the Chinese philosopher Lao Tzu stated: "To regard differences as equality, that is true greatness."

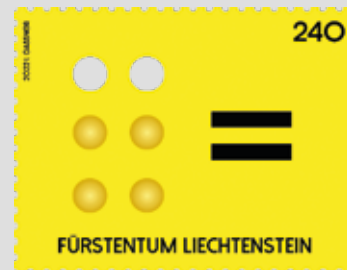
We approach this theme with the new special stamp "equal=equal" (face value: CHF 2.40). As just one of countless examples of the challenges surrounding the subject of equality, we have chosen Braille, a tactile writing system developed for visually impaired

people. The equals sign (=) is graphically depicted once in Braille and once in black print. The neon yellow background draws the viewer's attention to the sign.

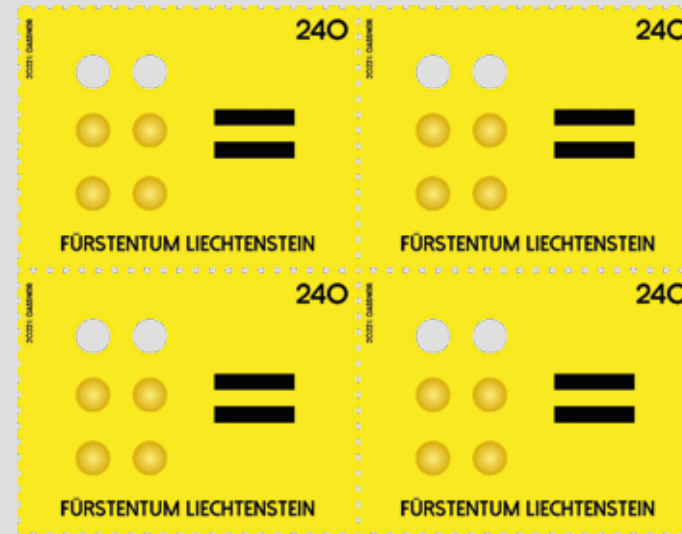
The individual Braille characters consist of six dots, three arranged vertically and two horizontally. These form the grid for the combinations with which letters, numbers and other characters are represented. For correct legibility of the character on the special stamp, the upper two dots were punched and the lower four dots were raised.



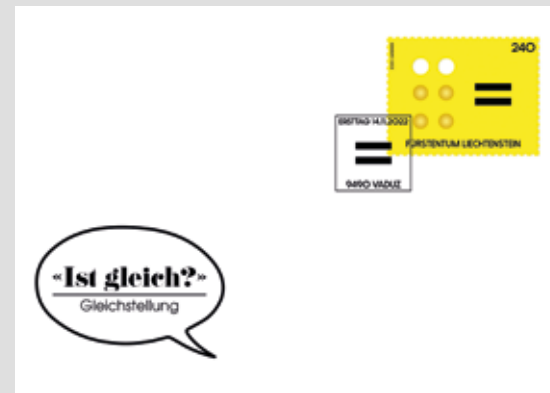

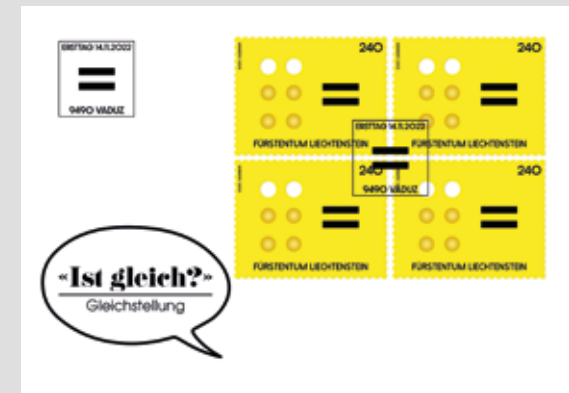

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

“Beigla” (face value: CHF 1.10) are tally sticks on which in olden days members of farmers’ alpine cooperatives etched their shares in forest and grazing rights. Their legal rights were recorded as notches made in tally sticks and were in use in the Liechtenstein mountain community of Triesenberg until the middle of the 19th century. Researchers assume that the term Beigla was derived from the Alemannic Beiala (notch).

The best-preserved, almost complete set of such tally sticks records the distribution of shares in the mountain pastures of Gross- and Chleistäg as well as Silum in Triesenberg. It comprises 59 pieces of wood of different sizes, onto which the members of the cooperative etched their respective share: a full transverse notch corresponds to a share, a half notch

to a half share and a dot to a quarter of a pasture share.

In order to match the tally sticks with their owners, in addition to the shares, a symbol indicating the corresponding household was also etched onto the tally sticks. Afterwards, the Beigla were bundled together on a string and usually kept in a drawer in the sacristy of the parish church. Changes in ownership were only allowed to be etched in the presence of the parish priest, judges, church stewards and jurors as well as alpine bailiffs.

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

In keeping with tradition, we end the philatelic year with our self-adhesive Christmas stamps. Four designs by Liechtenstein-based artist Jadwiga Falk-Ley are waiting to be sent out into the world bearing as many Christmas greetings as possible.

The motifs depict four Angels of Peace in different compositions, each assembled out of repeating elements in different sizes and arrangements. The collages "View from the Universe I" (face value: CHF 2.10), "View from the Universe II" (face value: CHF 0.90), "Angel of Peace in Gold" (face value: CHF 1.10) and "Angel of Peace in Silver" (face value: CHF 1.80) are featured in vibrant colours and intricate shapes.

Just as the paths to peace can be many and varied, so the artist also aims to leave room for individual interpretation of this theme. Jadwiga Falk-Ley, born in Bavaria in 1930, studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Berlin from 1949. She later moved to Spain where she devoted her attention to painting. She has lived and worked in Liechtenstein since 1960. The world of colour and shapes, both drawn and painted collages form the central theme of her work.

Chinese Sign of the Zodiac: Rabbit

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

The Rabbit completes a series of a total of twelve Chinese zodiac signs which we have issued every year as special stamps in the form of a filigree silhouette. This year, too, the souvenir sheet includes four identical stamps in red, the Chinese symbol for happiness.

On 22 January 2023, the Chinese New Year ushers in the "Year of the Rabbit" (face value: CHF 2.30). The Year of the Rabbit runs until 9 February 2024. In the horoscope of the Far East, this creature is a symbol of speed, agility and fertility. People born under the sign of the Rabbit are said to be especially peace-loving; according to astrologers, they tend to avoid conflicts and difficult situations. Thanks to their friendly nature, however, they are good company and know how to make the best of themselves. Yet a certain pessimism is attributed to Rabbits: they are conservative and insecure and averse to change, explain the astrologers.

Our collectors know that the souvenir sheet itself is also die-cut in the shape of the respective animal. It was enhanced with foil stamping in gold. The four special stamps are individually detachable and self-adhesive.
