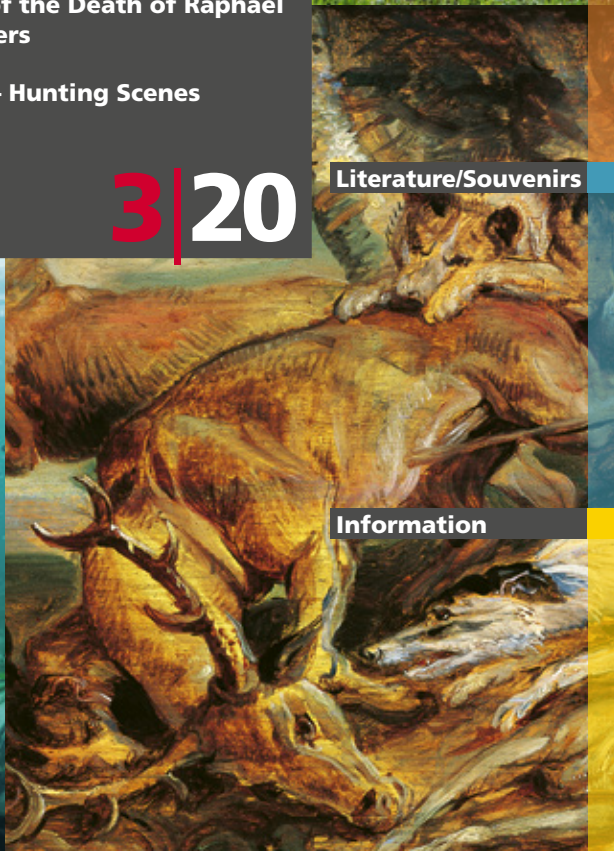

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

Italian painter and architect Raphael lived from 1483 to 1520 and is considered to be one of the most important artists of the Italian High Renaissance. In addition to his career as a painter in Florence and at the papal court in Rome, he also became site manager of St. Peter's Basilica and supervisor of Roman antiquities. During his lifetime he enjoyed the privilege of being known only by his first name and even today few people know his full name: Raffaello Sanzio da Urbino. The souvenir sheet published to mark the 500th anniversary of his death features one of his famous works as well as a "Self-portrait" (face value: CHF 6.30) of the artist.

Raphael painted the fresco "The School of Athens" for Pope Julius II between 1510 and 1511 in the "Stanza della Segnatura" of the Vatican, the original room where documents were signed within the Papal apartments. The painting, which is about 7.7 metres wide, shows a monumental interior in which a gathering of eminent scientists and philosophers from the Antiquity to the Renaissance is taking place. The title of the painting refers to the outstanding philosophical school of thought of ancient Greece. In the spirit of the Renaissance, the fresco celebrates ancient thought as the origin of European culture, its philosophy and sciences.

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

The series with village views of all of the municipalities of the Liechtenstein Oberland continues in this issue by taking us to Balzers. The southernmost municipality of the Principality has around 4,700 inhabitants and covers an area of almost 20 square kilometres. The stamps printed on sheets of 12 show black-and-white photographs of buildings with landscape scenery in the background in different shades of colour.

Today's "Mill" (face value: CHF 1.00) in Balzers was built in 1837 as an extension of an already existing mill. It was the first property to be supplied with self-generated electricity in 1918. The building was

placed under protection by the Princely Government in 1992 and renovated in the following two years. The mill has been operating again since 1994 and today focuses on organic production.

Originally a hamlet, "Mäls" (face value: CHF 1.80) belongs to the municipality of Balzers and is today a village district, which has grown together with the village district of Balzers since the early 20th century. The first traces of settlement in the Mälsner area date from the third century AD. The area around the medieval residential tower and St. Peter's Chapel, which are the focus of the second special stamp, is probably the oldest part of the village.

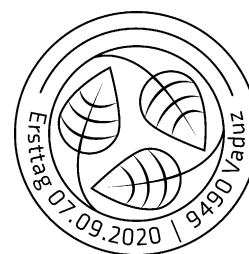
Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein



With the "Globe" (face value: CHF 6.30), a stamp embroidered from recycled PET thread, Philately Liechtenstein would like to draw attention to the topic of environmental protection and especially to the recovery of recyclable materials from waste. The stamp was produced by embroidery manufacturer Hämmerle & Vogel in Lustenau, Austria. For this purpose, 3,100 PET bottles with a volume of 600 ml each were processed to make cleaned flakes before producing a new high-quality polyester yarn from them. Seventy-five metres of thread were processed for each stamp. With an issue of 40,000 stamps, this means that three million metres of recycled polyester thread were used. This length is sufficient to surround

the external border of the Principality of Liechtenstein forty times. A comparison of the amount of work involved is equally impressive: While the embroidery machine with over one million revolutions produced the issue in the shortest possible time, a single hand embroiderer would take about 25 years to produce all the stamps.

The new, five-centimetre self-adhesive stamp in the shape of a globe is not only intended as a collector's item or for franking a postal item, it can also decorate your own clothes or other accessories to show your personal commitment to environmental protection and sustainability.

The multipart series with motifs from the collections of the Prince of Liechtenstein is continued with two paintings by Peter Paul Rubens (1577-1640). The artist of Flemish origin was one of the most famous Baroque painters and diplomats of the Spanish-Habsburg crown. His works are characterised by light and colour.

tribute during the harvest festival. Atalante, a virgin raised among hunters, rushes to the aid of the beset spear throwers Telamon and Peleus and hits the boar with her arrow behind the ear. While the wounded animal writhes in pain, Meleager runs from the right and strikes a fatal blow.

"The Hunt of the Meleager and the Atalante" (face value: CHF 2.20) shows how Greece's bravest warriors gather to fight an angry wild boar. The beast was sent to King Oineus of Calydonia by Diana, the hunting goddess, in revenge for the failure to pay her

It is assumed that the oil sketch "The Hunt of Diana" (face value: CHF 1.50) is a counterpart to the painting mentioned above. In this picture, Diana and her hunters rush forwards to a stag which, surrounded by the hounds and hit by a spear, falls to the ground while a hind tries to escape in the background.

Campione

The war in northern Italy prevented the Campione exclave, which was surrounded by Swiss territory, from replenishing its exhausted stock of Italian stamps for a long time. At the instigation of the Italian legation in Bern, the local administration of Campione issued these communal stamps; they were used for local post in the exclave itself, and from 20 May 1944 onwards, the Swiss postal administration also transported consignments franked with such stamps at Swiss domestic rates throughout the entire postal territory of Switzerland. Validity of all issues until 31 May 1952.

Austria

In the context of the series on "Formula 1 Legends", the Austrian Post issued a special stamp on Michael Schumacher in 2006. Despite the most careful checks of the stamp layout, a small but very significant error crept in: The dates of his World Cup titles were not correct. The error was discovered after printing, but before delivery. The stamp was produced a second time, this time with the correct years. The differences, caused by different printing technologies and printers, are no doubt of great interest to philatelists.

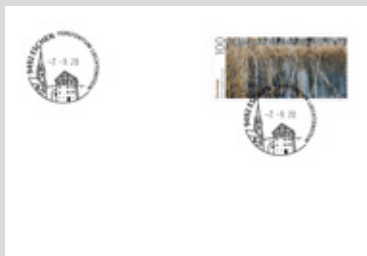

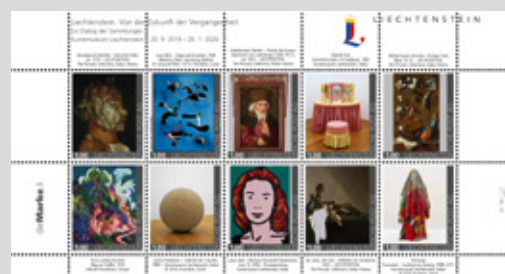

John Paul II – born Karol Józef Wojtyła - was the 264th Pope of the Roman Catholic Church (1978-2005), the first Pole and also the first non-Italian in this office since 1523. Less known until today is the fact that John Paul II was also an important philosopher and thinker. According to Christoph Böhr, editor of the "Wojtyła-Studien" and professor at the University of Heiligenkreuz (Austria), Wojtyła "[...] was without any doubt the most outstanding among the philosophers who ever climbed the Cathedra Petri".

On 18 May 2020 John Paul II would have been 100 years old. In Liechtenstein, his visit to the Principality on 8 September 1985 is also particularly well remembered. In his honour, Philately Liechtenstein has published a souvenir sheet under the "dieMarke.li" label. This sheet is not an official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein, but an additional product of Liechtenstein Post AG.
